

CAROLS IN THE CAVES



For the past twenty two years, the Waitomo Caves Choir has met in Waitomo Caves Village from September until December to prepare their annual Christmas programme that is performed in the iconic Cathedral of the Waitomo Glowworm Cave. Over three nights they perform a mix of unaccompanied Christmas music interspersed with traditional carols for approximately 600 people.

In addition to the Christmas programme, the choir performs at various concerts and functions throughout the year and has featured on NZ television. The choir, composed of unauditioned singers from a small rural community, has received high praise and produced several CDs with a new release in the pipeline for late 2014.

Our members are farmers, teachers, cave guides, students, young and old. Dedicated singers can be found using their practice CDs whilst working on the farm, milking cows, walking or driving to work, before going to sleep at night or first thing in the morning.
