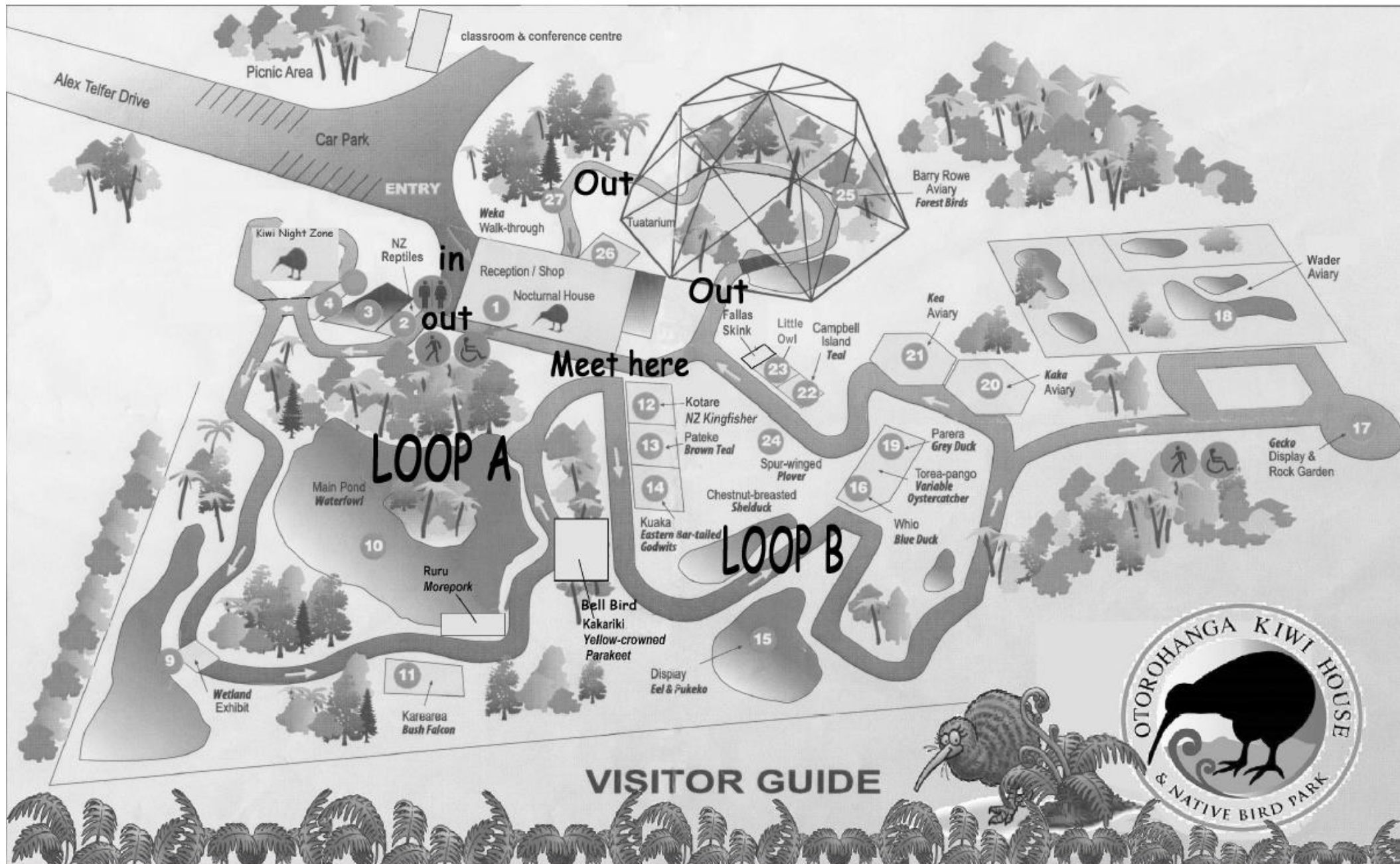


Please minimise noise, walk on paths only, stand back from barriers (such as viewing windows and mesh).
